After all, she was merely a "missionary," while he was an "apostle." Unfortunately, Apostle To Islam: A Biography Of Samuel M. Zwemer by J. Christy Wilson did not at all live up to my high expectations, nor to the high \$33 price I paid. The book starts off as most biographies do, with a modest summary of the subject's journey from birth into adulthood.

In the judgment of historian Kenneth Scott Latourette, "No one through all the centuries of Christian missions to the Muslims has deserved better than Dr. Zwemer the designation of Apostle to Islam." 1. Samuel Marinus Zwemer was born in Vriesland, Michigan in 1867, the thirteenth child in a Reformed Church minister's family.

Samuel Marinus Zwemer Missionary, mobilizer, explorer, theologian, and author. Often referred to as 'the Apostle to Islam'.

Apostle to Islam. One of the most celebrated Protestant missionaries of the twentieth century, Zwemer made his home in Arabia and Egypt for most of 38 years (1890-1929). Initially an evangelist, he became a writer, publisher, and peripatetic conference speaker who, as much as anyone, introduced twentieth-century Christians to Islam.
