Both open and laparoscopic approaches are covered for surgical diseases of the esophagus, stomach, duodenum, spleen, liver, pancreas, and biliary tree.

Gallbladder surgery when performed through the small cuts and a camera is called laparoscopic cholecystectomy. Removing the gallbladder is the preferred treatment for the majority of people who have gallstones that cause symptoms. Laparoscopic cholecystectomy requires several small incisions in the abdomen to allow the insertion of surgical instruments and a small video camera.

Absolute CI: Inability to tolerate general anesthesia, suspicion of Gallbladder cancer (laparoscopic surgery not able to correct) Complications of Cholecystectomy Pancreatitis (because of close proximity to CBD)
