If, then, the other passages that mention baptism (see above) are of the same import, it follows that they likewise refer to water baptism, not Spirit baptism. Baptism is immersion Both Romans 6:3-4 and Colossians 2:12 make it clear that the baptism of these passages involves both an immersion in something, and a being raised from the same substance.

Pastors Bud & Betty Miller on Baptism in the Holy Spirit. The baptism in the Holy Spirit is a crisis experience just as our initial conversion experience was. We cannot be gradually baptized in the Holy Ghost, just as we cannot be gradually baptized in water.

In virtually all cases, those who claim to have Holy Spirit baptism also believe in some form of water baptism. The Bible teaches that today there is only ONE baptism - Ephesians 4:3-6. To have Biblical unity, we must recognize there is only one of each of the seven things God lists here. We can no more be true Christians and believe there is more than one baptism, than we can be true Christians and believe there is more than one true God and Father.

Water baptism is an act of obedience that follows conversion to portray symbolically the washing away of our sins. Water baptism calls for immersion instead of sprinkling.

The first initial sign of being baptized by the power of the Holy Spirit is speaking in tongues (Acts 2).
