Gang members use hand signs to communicate with each other and to challenge rival members or law enforcement officers in what they call throwing signs. After forming in Los Angeles in the early 1970s, the Bloods street gang spread to the East Coast and formed sets. These sets include the Piru Bloods, Fruit Town...

The shift helped the gang spread beyond California. In the early 1990s the East Coast Bloods (also called the United Blood Nation) was established by prison inmates at Rikers Island, New York, and it became a significant presence, especially in New York City, where they outnumbered Crips.

The Bloods, also known as Original Blood Family (OBF), are a primarily African-American street gang founded in Los Angeles, California. The gang is widely known for its rivalry with the Crips. They are identified by the red color worn by their members and by particular gang symbols, including distinctive hand signs.
