The Bulgarian Black Sea Coast runs all the way from the mouth of Rezovo River on the Turkish border to the south to Cape Siviburun on the Romanian border to the north and constitutes the country's eastern border. The total length of the coastline is approximately 350 km, 200 km of which are taken up by clean and vast fine-sand beaches.

The Bulgarian Black Sea Coast (Bulgarian: ??????????, Ч?рnomori?), also known as the Bulgarian Riviera, covers the entire eastern bound of Bulgaria stretching from the Romanian Black Sea resorts in the north to European Turkey in the south, along 378 km of coastline. White and golden sandy beaches occupy approximately 130 km of the 378 km long coast.
