Posterior Pill Opacity – A Typical Cataract Surgery Problem. One of the most common cataract surgery complications is a posterior pill opacity (also called posterior pill opacification or PCO).

In patients with additional eye diseases such as Glaucoma or Diabetic Retinopathy the complication rate may increase.
