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Since 1984, the year of the publication of its first edition, the famous “Blue Guide” has been the international reference for paediatricians and neuropaediatricians with regard to epileptic syndromes in infants, children and adolescents.

FS can precede all other epilepsy syndromes of infancy, childhood and adolescence. There is a strong genetic propensity to febrile seizures and although no genetic mutations have been identified in children with common febrile seizures (but see below) a number of genetic loci are implicated.
