The following is a list of works of painting, sculpture and architecture by the Italian Renaissance artist Michelangelo. Lost works are included, but not commissions that Michelangelo never made. Michelangelo also left many drawings, sketches, and some works in poetry.

Michelangelo's extreme genius left little scope for works that escaped his influence, damning all his contemporaries to settle for aping him. Appreciation of Michelangelo's artistic mastery has endured for centuries, and his name has become synonymous with the best of the Renaissance Art.

And so from his first visit to the Eternal City in 1496 Michelangelo lived much of his adult life in the city, gracing it with some of the greatest masterpieces of Western art. According to his friend and biographer Giorgio Vasari, Michelangelo was 'supreme not in one art alone but in all three' – that is, painting, sculpture and architecture.
