Northwestern Scholarships. The University awarded \$190 million to undergraduate students in 2018-19, and approximately 61% of undergraduates received a Northwestern University Scholarship. Students who apply for aid will automatically be considered for all forms of institutional assistance listed below.

The Northwestern College theatre department offers a variety of scholarships for students involved in theatre productions at NWC. Theatre Production Scholarship The Theatre Production Scholarship is available to students who are—or plan to be—involved in theatre productions at NWC.

In 2018 an NHSI student was awarded a scholarship from the American Theatre Wing's Andrew Lloyd Webber Initiative. 2019 applications are due January 18, 2019. There is no fee to apply. Scholarships First Year Scholarship: You will receive a scholarship of \$2,000 each quarter of your first year for a total of \$6,000. Teaching Assistantships (TA-SHIPS): You will receive a TA-ship for one quarter of your second year. This will cover your entire tuition for that quarter and provide an additional stipend. THEATRE 220-0 Introduction to Theatre Design (1 Unit) Introduces the principles and elements of visual design as they relate to the theatre design areas of scenery, costume, and lighting. Applies these principles and elements to a play by creating scenery, costume, and lighting design ideas based on text analysis, point of view, and research in a production notebook format.
